Military Retirees and eligible dependents who visit military installations using the Automated Installation Entry (AIE) II Plus System should be aware the system may NOT recognize older ID cards; (those with the visible Social Security Number - SSN)

Retirees and eligible dependents should schedule an appointment at the [Office of the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Army \(ID Card Facility - Fort Belvoir\)](#) or [visit their nearest ID Card issuing facility](#).

According to Fort Belvoir Public Affairs, AIE increases security for everyone who lives, works, shops or attends events on the installation by verifying identity and ensuring they meet Army-approved access standards against FBI criminal and federal authority databases. Once the card is registered, AIE scans them for criminal background, security alerts or installation debarment.
